



## Breast Cancer Statistics

### In Canada

- Breast Cancer is the most common cancer among Canadian women.
- An estimated 1 in 9 women will be diagnosed with breast cancer in her lifetime.
- More than an estimated 22,700 Canadian women will be diagnosed with the disease and 5,400 will die of it in 2009.
- An estimated 180 Canadian men will develop breast cancer, resulting in 50 deaths in 2009 alone.
- On average, 437 Canadian women will be diagnosed with breast cancer and 104 women will die of the disease each week.

### In Alberta

- In 2009, there will be an estimated 2,000 new cases of breast cancer diagnosed amongst Alberta women.
- An estimated 430 Albertan women will die of breast cancer in 2009

## Cervical Cancer Statistics

### In Canada

- In 2009, an estimated 1,300 Canadian women will be diagnosed with cervical cancer and 380 will die of it.

### In Alberta

- An estimated 160 women in Alberta will be diagnosed with cervical cancer leading to an estimated 40 deaths in 2009.

## Ovarian Cancer Statistics

### In Canada

- In 2009, an estimated 2,500 Canadian women will be diagnosed with ovarian cancer and 1,750 will die of it.\*

### In Alberta

- In 2009, an estimated 160 new cases of cervical cancer will be diagnosed amongst women in Alberta and 40 women will die from the disease.

## Endometrial Cancer Statistics

### In Alberta

- An estimated 332 new cases of endometrial cancer are diagnosed each year in Alberta\*\*
- An estimated 50 deaths are related to endometrial cancer each year\*\*

## Uterine Cancer Statistics

### In Canada

- In 2009, an estimated 4,400 new cases of uterine cancer were diagnosed in Canada and 800 women will die from the disease.

### In Alberta

- An estimated 420 new cases of uterine cancer will be diagnosed in Alberta in 2009, and 70 women will die from the disease in that time\*\*
